This year the **34th Community Transportation Roadeo of New Jersey** sponsored by **NJ COST** and **NJ TRANSIT** will be held on **Saturday, April 13th** at **Union County Educational Services Commission, 45 Cardinal Drive, Westfield, NJ 07090**.

The **Roadeo** provides an opportunity for vehicle operators to demonstrate their expertise through a variety of exercises designed to replicate the skills required of them on a daily basis. The top competitor receives the title **“New Jersey State Community Transportation Roadeo Champion”** while their employer has the honor of displaying the **Championship Trophy** for one year.

All drivers will be given recognition of their participation in this state event. The top four drivers receive an award in addition to a Gift Card. The 1st and 2nd place winners will go on to represent New Jersey at the **National Roadeo** held as part of the annual **Community Transportation Association of America’s Expo** in **Palm Springs, California in May**.

Our Roadeo is one of the premiere community transportation competitions in the country. We encourage you and members of your staff to support the drivers by participating as a judge.

On the day of the Roadeo, registration will begin at 9:15am. Final work assignments will be confirmed at that time. The Judge’s walk-through of the course begins promptly at 10:00 am. The Roadeo is held rain or shine so it is important to dress accordingly. A light breakfast and lunch will be provided.

It is our hope that you will volunteer to serve as a judge and help us acknowledge the service our drivers provide to some of the most vulnerable New Jersey residents on a daily basis.

- Set-up crew
 - Set-up tables and chairs
 - Help set-up breakfast
 - Helping hands where needed
- Passenger Assistance and Mobility Device Securement
 - Judges **MUST** be a **PASS CERTIFIED TRAINER**
- Smoothness of Operations/Timekeeper
 - Onboard vehicle judge – no motion sickness allowed
- Registration Table
 - Assignment over once everyone has registered
 - Consider taking on another assignment to occupy the rest of the day
- Runners
 - Walk the obstacle course
 - Collect score sheets / deliver to scoring station
- Driver Team Captains
 - Drivers will be assigned to teams after registration
 - Get team together to report to the various
- Scoring
 - Must have no connection with participants
 - Administer and score written test
 - Enter obstacle score data on final score sheet on the computer
- Starter
 - Collects participation number from driver and affixes it to front of vehicle
 - Instructs driver to adjust seat, mirrors, etc.
 - Times the start of the vehicle on the course so it does not interfere with other vehicles already in progress
- Clean-up Crew
 - Fold tables / stack chairs
 - Bring course equipment to POD
 - General helping hand
 - Drivers have been asked to help too
